Session times



Both rooms welcome children for fifteen hours, spread over the week. This means your child is entitled to five, three hour sessions. Depending upon availability, you will be offered either a morning or an afternoon session.


Morning session	8.40 to 11-40

Your child will learn through play-based activities. They will be learning about routine and developing early literacy and maths skills, learning about the world around them and social skills.

Language and communication is an important focus in all activities.

Our Nursery is run by a qualified Early Years teacher. We plan and deliver activities covering the Early Years curriculum.

To keep you informed of your child's activities and progress, we use a secure online learning journal called Tapestry. You can sign up to this using your email and then you can see what your child is doing each week. It allows you to share pictures and stories from home too!


We also invite parents in for a parent meeting each term and share a written report. For our two-year-olds this in the form of the integrated review.
